## Farmer Health Screenings

*In New York State, findings from a recent statewide study of farmers, farm workers and farm family members revealed:*

A high rate of hearing loss

An increased prevalence of skin cancer and pre-cancerous lesions

An increased exposure to dust and environmental allergens

An increased rate of arthritis of the knee, shoulder and hip
